February Focus:

- **I Love to Read!** month

- **Math:**
 - Counting by 1's to 50 and counting down from 10-0

 - Ten Frames
 - AAB and ABB patterns
- **Language Arts:**
 - Phonemic Awareness: rhyming ("what rhymes with fan?"), syllables in words, initial and final sound identification.
 - Journal writing using initial, final sounds and periods and making lists.
 - Printing name using lower case letters and forming the letters neatly & correctly
 - Learning new letters and sounds: Ff, Ll, Vv, Dd and Nn
 - new sight words: **he, she, we**
- **Unit Studies:** The People Around Me
- **Art:** Marble Painting

Please practice this memory verse with your child at home. I will assess them on this memory work the last week of February.

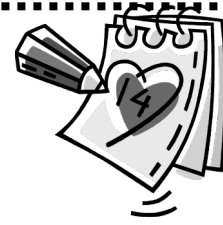
February Memory Verse:
