#### Classroom Volunteers:

Kindergarten classrooms are very busy places and having volunteers is always greatly appreciated! If you are interested in volunteering in our classroom, I would love to have you! Classroom volunteers often work on a variety of tasks including assisting with snacks, centres and art projects. Our volunteer times are Tuesdays and Thursdays from 10:00 - 11:30. It would be so helpful if you are able to volunteer every other week or once a month. Please let me know as soon as possible if this works for you so a schedule can be made.

Parent volunteers are also required for making play dough and joining us on field trips or for special events. These volunteer opportunities will be mentioned in our monthly newsletters.

#### **Morning Arrivals:**

Children who arrive before school begins in the morning may either wait in line or play on the playground until the school bell rings. Our morning school bell rings at 8:20 a.m. Kindergarten children will then line up at the east entrance. This area is marked with a 'K'. The teacher on morning duty will then proceed to let the children inside. For the first while I will be outside to assist the kindergarten children coming into the school. **Note**: You will hear bells ring from the River East High School which may actually sound louder than our bell at times!

❖ Let's start to line up at this location beginning our next school day.

#### Birthdays:

Birthdays are so special to kindergarteners! Children will be acknowledged on their individual birthdays. When it is your child's birthday, you are welcome to send a birthday treat to school to share with your child's classmates. We have 18 children in our class. We will celebrate our summer birthdays at the end of June.



**Birthday Invitations**: If your child is having a birthday party and will be inviting friends from kindergarten, please be sensitive about when and how you extend the invitations. It can be very hard for a child to understand why he/she may not be invited to a party. I know that passing out invitations at school is convenient, however, I do ask that unless you invite all the boys or the all the girls (or everyone!) that you deliver the invitations some other way (i.e. mail) or with a phone call to the families.




