High Frequency Words (Popcorn Words)
We will be learning high frequency words this year in Kindergarten. We do several activities in class with each word, such as reading poems and using these words in our journals. A mini reader using the words will come home once we have read through the reader several times. Please encourage your child to read this booklet many times at home and point to the words as he/she reads.

Our class is currently learning the following high frequency words:


Collecting Food for Hope Centre
