April Highlights

- Bible: We will review Christ's Death and Resurrection. We will also learn about Jesus' early ministry.
- In Unit Studies, we will continue learning about Paper. We will learn about different types and uses of paper. Most importantly, we will learn how to be good stewards of paper.
- Math Stations: Measurement (length), Number 6, and Number 7
- Additional Math Skills:
 - our new counting goal is 100!
 - skip counting by 10s to 100
- Phonemic Awareness: rhyme production, initial, final and middle sound identification and segmenting consonant-vowel-consonant words into sounds (ie. cat = /c/ - /a/ - /t/)

- Printing first and last name using lower case letters and forming the letters neatly & correctly
- New letters and sounds: **Oo, Qq, Uu, Ii**
- New popcorn words: **in & and**

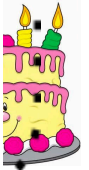
