April Highlights

- Math Stations: Measurement (length), Number 6, and Number 7
- Additional Math Skills:

 - skip counting by 10s to 100
- Phonemic Awareness: rhyme production, initial, final and middle sound identification and segmenting consonant-vowel-consonant words into sounds (ie. cat = /c/ - /a/ - /t/)
- Journal writing and list writing with initial, medial and final letters
- Printing first and last name using lower case letters and forming the letters neatly & correctly
- New letters and sounds: Oo, Qq, Uu, Ii
- New popcorn words: **in** & **and**
