May Highlights

Math Stations:

We will continue to practice counting by ones and tens to 100.

Centres:

1. Working on Writing: writing about paper and trees in our journals
2. Reading: "A Tree" reader
3. Word Work: vowel identification and printing CVC words

New letters: **Ii, Xx, Yy and Zz**

New popcorn words: *look, at*

Phonemic Awareness: segmenting words into sounds (ie. cat= /c/ /a/ /t/), blending sounds into words (ie. /c/ /a/ /t/= cat) and identifying medial sounds (short vowels).

We will continue to practice writing lists.

Unit Studies: We are continuing our unit on Trees. We will explore the parts of a tree, types of trees, seasons of a tree, gifts from a tree, and as stewards of God's earth, our responsibility to trees.
